HISTORY OF THE WASHTENAW 100

While attending the Indianapolis 500 in the spring of 1971, a gentleman from Ann Arbor was invited to attend a meeting of a unique group. As a guest of the Indy Club, he learned of the special endowments this organization made to the families of law enforcement officers and firefighters who lost their lives in the line of duty.

Inspired by the Indy Club's contributions, he approached twelve of his close friends. Those twelve enthusiastically demanded that such a group be established in Washtenaw County. Christened The Washtenaw 100 in the hope that the group would have at least one hundred members, the first meeting was held in the fall of 1971.

Operating anonymously and meeting once a year, it was determined that the primary purpose of the group would be to provide immediate monetary assistance to the family of a law enforcement officer or firefighter within 24 hours of a duty death. Although police and fire departments offer insurance coverage that in time will assist the families with their financial needs, The Washtenaw 100 provides funds immediately at the time of crisis.


Seeking to expand their benefits, in 1977 the Washtenaw 100 began awarding up to ten scholarships each year to children of active law enforcement officers and firefighters. Since that time, the Washtenaw 100 has awarded more than a quarter of a million dollars in college scholarships.

The Washtenaw 100 is proud to support the families of the men and women of law enforcement and firefighting personnel who give so selflessly that we all may enjoy a safe community.

PURPOSE OF THE WASHTENAW 100

- ▶ Provide immediate funding to the families of Washtenaw County law enforcement officers or firefighters who die in the line of duty.
- ▶ Assist with furthering the education of children of Washtenaw County law enforcement officers and firefighters by awarding college scholarships annually.
- ▶ Annually recognize the outstanding law enforcement officer and firefighter of the year in Washtenaw County.
- ▶ Entertain special equipment need requests of law enforcement and firefighting departments and assist in fulfilling those needs whenever possible.
